**AP Exam Schedule – May 2027**

The 2027 AP Exams will be administered over two weeks in May: **May 3-14**.

Purchase Deadline: **November 7**

- Students must purchase exams on Total Registration by November 7

AP Classroom Indicator Deadline: **November 7**

- Students must join their AP teacher's AP Classroom section on the College Board website and have their indicator changed to "yes" for taking the exam by November 7.
- Every student who indicates "yes" must also have purchased the exam through Myschoolbucks. If not, an exam will not be ordered for the student.

**ITEMS TO BRING TO THE EXAM:**

- CSArts-SGV Student ID (or print out of your face and name from Aeries) – REQUIRED
- Four (4) Sharpened No. 2 Pencils with Erasers - REQUIRED
- Two (2) Black or Blue Ink Pens – REQUIRED
- Watch (no watches that beep, have alarms or have internet access are allowed) - OPTIONAL
- Water and/or snack (A water bottle without any markings / labels only will be permitted. Water and snack will be stored by the proctor and is only accessible during break time.)
- Calculators – Read the AP Calculator Policy [here](#). Students may bring up to two of the approved calculators to the following exams: Biology, Calculus AB and BC, Statistics, Environmental Science, Physics 1, Chemistry, and Macroeconomics.

**ITEMS NOT TO BRING TO THE EXAM – They will not be permitted in any exam room!**

- Cell phones of any kind, smart device of any kind
- iPods, iPads, MP3 players or any other personal listening or communication device
- Laptops, Tablet PC's, etc., anything that can access the internet (for digital exams, Chromebooks will be provided)
- Watches that beep or have an alarm
- Books, compasses, protractors, mechanical pencils, No. 3 pencils, correcting fluid or tape, dictionaries, highlighters, notes, colored paper, clipboards, reference guides, or scratch paper
- Ear plugs
- Clothing or shoes with subject-related information
- Food or drink that is not the approved kind listed above
