Acting (Grades 9-12)

All CSArts-SGV applicants should include one (1) **Personal Statement** when submitting their online application.

Personal Statement

(minimum of 300 words)

An essay describing why they are passionate about attending an art-focused program.

Digital Placement Activity Guidelines

Please submit 2 YouTube videos based on the following:

- Please prepare 2 one-minute monologues that you *enjoy*. The **monologues must be from published plays** and **memorized**. The monologues can be contemporary or classical. It is recommended that the two monologues be contrasting in nature.
- At the beginning of the videos, please slate by clearly stating your name, the grade you are applying to and the title of the play your monologue is from.
- After you have recorded your YouTube videos, please be sure they are set to **Unlisted** to protect your privacy.
- YouTube videos should be specifically produced for your CSArts-SGV Placement Activity. Do not include filmed excerpts from previous stage performances.
