### **Ballet & Contemporary Dance (Grades 6-12)**

All CSArts-SGV applicants should include one (1) **Personal Statement** when submitting their online application.

#### **Personal Statement**

*(minimum of 300 words)*

An essay describing why they are passionate about attending an art-focused program.

#### **Placement Activity Guidelines**

**In-person Placement Activities have concluded. Once your online application has been submitted and processed, the Director will reach out to you with instructions on completing your Digital Placement Activity.**

*Students may not select this conservatory for enrollment if they do not demonstrate the minimum proficiency in this Placement Activity, therefore it is strongly recommended that they also complete a Placement Activity for one other conservatory.*
