ACTING CONSERVATORY In-Person Placement Activity

Acting (Grades 9-12)

All CSArts-SGV applicants should include one (1) **Personal Statement** when submitting their online application.

Personal Statement

(minimum of 300 words)

An essay describing why they are passionate about attending an art-focused program.

Placement Activity Guidelines

All Acting Conservatory applicants will participate in an in-person Placement Activity. ***Your application to the Acting Conservatory is not complete without participation in this session.*** Choose, prepare, memorize, and share 2 one-minute monologues that you *enjoy*. Please be prepared to share your 2 one-minute monologues during the in-person placement activity. The ***monologues must be from published plays and memorized.*** The monologues can be contemporary or classical. It is recommended that the two monologues be contrasting in nature.
